

## HAT Footy Tipping 2006 Trivia

- The total number of tippers has increased again this year

- Tippers: 167 Aurora; 28 Transend; 50 Hydro; 125 Family and Friends  
*(Need more Transend and Hydro people for next year!)*
- In 2006 there was only 1 round (round 10) when all 8 favourites won. In 2005 there were no rounds where all the favourites won!! In 2004 there were 2 rounds when all 8 favourites got up.
- 188 (52%) put in tips for all 22 rounds. 333 (92%) people put in tips for 18 rounds or more.
- We gave away a total of \$2,250 in Weekly Prizes (Round Winners, Hot Tips, All 8 Jackpot and Spot Prizes)
- The most certain result of the year was West Coast beating Brisbane Lions at Subiaco in Round 5.
  - 13 people went for Brisbane, including Pauline Taylor, (who also featured with this dubious distinction last year). At least this year she had the excuse that she follows Brisbane. What were you thinking Pauline?
  - 340 backed West Coast, who won 18.14 122 to 9.9 63.
- The biggest upset of the year was in round 3 when Hawthorn 15.11 101 beat Geelong 6.13 49. Only 7 tippers got it - 339 didn't. 3 of the lucky ones were loyal Hawthorn supporters Joe Nicholson, Jenny Petrusma and Travis Holmquest. Not sure what excuse Lyndon Newell's kids, Luke Taylor, Jacque Trower and Katie Connors had.
- Most *Deluded* supporters were Essendon and Least *Deluded* were Fremantle
- Ian Colvin's (from Hydro) run of luck has finished He was 2<sup>nd</sup> in 2004, equal 3<sup>rd</sup> in 2005, but finished equal 115<sup>th</sup> this year.

- Looks like Collingwood and Geelong have the most loyal supporters both having 11 followers who tipped them every round. There wasn't a single Carlton supporter who stuck with them all year.
