

## HAT Footy Tipping 2018 Trivia

- Hit Rate - has increased compared to 2017.
  - 2010 winner's HR was 68.2%
  - 2011 winner's HR was 78.04%
  - 2012 winner's HR was 78.28%
  - 2013 winner's HR was 75.76% (Harder with Suns improving and Gazza dominating.)
  - 2014 winner's HR was 74.2 and 74.7%
  - 2015 winner's HRs were 73.2, 72.2 and 71.7%
  - 2016 winner's HR was 74.7%
  - 2017 winner's HR was 70.20%
  - 2018 winner's HR was 73.23%

- Round 2 was the toughest tipping week with 6 upsets. Back then we thought Carlton losing was an upset! Corinna Woolford did best on the hardest week of the year with an impressive 7/9.
- Tipper Tote Tas Favourites ended on equal 20<sup>th</sup> with 147 points, a full 20 tips better than the 2017 result of 127 points. - Just 6 points behind the winner!.
- Joe Average (who tips the most popular tips from HAT tippers) was back in equal 66<sup>th</sup>, 10 points from the winner.
- Our winner, Zack Hepburn submitted tips for all 23 rounds. He bombed out in round 2 of Hot Tips picking Geelong who lost to Hawthorn. He managed to stay alive for 4 weeks in Hot Tips #2, until Geelong let him down again losing to Hawthorn.
- Ladder Predictions: Start of the year - you put the AFL ladder in to what you thought it would be come Round 23...
  - On average Adelaide were selected at 1. They actually finished 12<sup>th</sup>. How wrong we were
  - Collingwood were collectively selected at 13<sup>th</sup>, but managed 10 places better at 3<sup>rd</sup>. Go Pies!
  - Fremantle in 14<sup>th</sup> was the only team to all finish exactly where we collectively expected.
  - Adelaide, Port Adelaide and Essendon were all expected to make the eight - but didn't.
- Tippers: 32 Aurora; 119 TasNetworks; 23 Hydro; 159 Family and Friends

There was only one round this year when all the favourites won. That was lucky round 13. All the other rounds had at least 1 upset - with round 2 being the toughest with 6 upsets: Kangas beat Saints, Port beat Swans, Suns beat Blues, Dockers beat Bombers, Hawks beat Cats and Eagles beat Bulldogs.

- 168 tippers (just over 50%) put in tips for all 23 rounds.
- 40 tippers (12.0%) put in tips for their team all 22 games.

We gave away a total of just over three grand (\$2,800) in Weekly Prizes (Round Winners, Hot Tips, Quarterly Tipping, Power Tipping and Shaw Thing Tipping)

- The most certain result of the year was Richmond beating Fremantle at the MCG in Round 7.
  - 312 people backed the Tigers, who won 15.20 110 to 4.9 33
  - Naomi Allchin was the only tipper to submit a tip for Freo in the game.
- There were 61 upsets all year. That is games where team most people tipped didn't win.
- The biggest upset of the year was in round 9 when Essendon 12.12 84 beat Geelong 7.8 50 @ the MCG. Only 7 tippers got it right! Including three loyal Bombers: Karen Jenkins, Jane Evans and Sam Thomas...
- Most *Deluded* supporters were Geelong and Least *Deluded* Port Adelaide
- This year no human tipper got 0 for a round when actually tipping. Computer Tipper Johnny Random got zero in round 16. PS: Johnny didn't manage a 9/9 round, and finished dead last on 38%, behind even Albert AwayGames.
- Lowest score for someone who entered tips every round was Geelong fan Lisa Snyman, with a score of 121. A hit rate of 58%. Good job Lisa for not giving up.
- This year the title of least Loyal Supporters goes to two who each tipped their team just once all year, for no wins:
  - Hugh Morris, Brisbane supporter, and
  - Mark Bresnehan, Carlton fan.
- Geelong had the most loyal supporters having 13 followers who tipped them every round.
